Dear Family Members:

The WTB Command Sergeant Major and I would like to personally welcome you to the Warrior Transition Battalion Family at Fort Campbell, Kentucky. Families are an integral part of their healing process. My staff and I are dedicated to assisting you, while providing that vital support to your Soldier. Both you and your Soldier will be treated with dignity and respect at all times during their assignment with the Warrior Transition Battalion.

Your Soldier will be assigned a Triad of Soldier Care, which will include a Primary Care Manager, a Nurse Case Manager, and a Squad Leader. Your Soldier's Triad will work together to develop a Comprehensive Transition plan for your Soldier which will include a plan for their medical care as well as participation in work, education, or other cognitive development programs. Your Soldier's Triad will coordinate with medical specialties as well as other agencies (such as Social Workers, Army Wounded Warrior Program (AW2), Veterans Administration, etc.) to provide both of you with support and education on the medical transition process whether that be return to duty or transition out of the military.

Your Soldier will in process the unit with the assistance of a squad leader. They will be individually counseled by their squad leader and other staff at various stages in their transition to ensure they understand their plan of care and status in the process. They will participate, and you are highly encouraged to attend, a series of briefings and classes. These briefings and classes along with their counseling sessions and appointments will ensure they have as much information as possible about the transition process, their medical care, and their benefits.

We have a Family Readiness Group (FRG) here at the Warrior Transition Battalion. The goal of the FRG is to ensure that you have the information, resources, and support you need as your Soldier goes through their healing process. We want to be here for the Family and provide you with as much support as we do your Soldier. The Family is an integral part of the Soldier's healing whether you are a Spouse, Parent, or Friend. You have a Triad of Care too. Your Triad consists of the FRG, your Soldier's Chain of Command, and the Soldier and Family Assistance Center (SFAC).

You and your Soldier have sacrificed much to our nation. Your Soldier deserves the very best care and assistance, as do you during this transition process. Our mission is to help your Soldier heal, and support you in any way we can.
